## THE CALLS TO MISSIONS

### Introduction

- Remembering computer passwords
- The ability to learn and remember is a gift from God
- The Bible commands us to remember various things like sharing the gospel
  
- Missions is sharing the gospel cross-culturally.

### Main point

**By God's power, we share the gospel in o\_\_\_\_\_**

**eternal destiny of the Lost.**

**I. Matthew's gospel emphasizes the j\_\_\_\_\_ of**

A. The controversy

B. The kernel of truth (John 5:24)

### C. Jesus and the sense of urgency

- Parables of the Talents, 19 virgins, and the Sheep and Goats (Matthew 25)
- Hebrews 9:27
- John 9:4
- If a person does not know Christ or respond positively to the gospel, he is condemned to spend eternity far away from God and face everlasting punishment.

### III. Luke's gospel emphasizes the n\_\_\_\_\_ -gritty of missions: sharing the gospel. Luke 24:46-47

- A. The "nitty-gritty" or crux of missions is always about sharing the gospel.
- B. Jesus not only performed miracles but also asked people to make a decision- to believe in him as the Messiah.
- C. The "ABC" of sharing the gospel.
  1. Admit your need to have your sins forgiven or else we are condemned to eternal judgment. (Romans 3:23, 6:23)
  2. Believe that Jesus died for your sins. (John 3:16, 1:12)
  3. Call out to Jesus- ask Him to forgive your sins and accept His free gift of eternal life. (Romans 10: 9-10, 13)

### IV. John and the book of Act's emphasize the divine

c\_\_\_\_\_ of missions: The Holy Spirit. John 20:21-22, Acts 1:8

- A. One of the greatest obstacles to missions or evangelism is fear.
- B. The Holy Spirit accompanies us.
  - "Paraclete"- called alongside
    1. Counselor/Comforter (John 14:16)
    2. Remain in believers. (John 14:17)
    3. Convict the world of sin. (John 16:8)
    4. Guide believers to the Truth. (John 16:13)
